

Family and MWR School Liaison Officer – Frequently Asked Questions

Q - What elementary school will my child attend?

A - We have three elementary (K-5) schools in Stuttgart. Robinson Barracks ES, Patch ES, and Stuttgart ES. Enrollment is determined by where you live. Each school has a designated zone. Maps are available at the school liaison office, schools, and other community locations. Another factor is your child's school eligibility status. If your child is eligible for school on a space-available basis, he or she is not guaranteed enrollment.

Q - How do I register my students in the schools?

A – Pre-registration is available at <https://www.dodea.edu/registration-process.cfm>. Final registration is at the school your child is attending. You must bring: Sponsor's orders; Birth certificate (K-2); Immunization record; proof of address.

Q - May I request an exception for my child to attend elementary school in a different zone?

A - Yes, you may request an Exception to Feeder with the school in your zone. This will initiate a process through DoDEA to determine if your request can be granted.

Q – Does DoDEA provide transportation to and from school?

A – Yes. DoDEA provides transportation to and from school for students living in the correct school zone. Applications are available at the DoDEA Transportation Office, located at Stuttgart High School. If your child is attending school with a space-available status, then this will also apply to transportation. Please note that transportation is provided for those living more than 1 mile from their school. This means that students are NOT transported from Panzer Housing to the schools on Panzer.

Q – Can my child attend German school?

A - Yes. Your child may attend German school. Contact the School Liaison Office for more information on how to best navigate the German school process.

Q – Is there a lunch program at the schools?

A – Yes. The school meal program is through AAFES. Once you register your child in school, request a student ID number. Create a student account at the AAFES customer Service area. Free and Reduced Lunch Program information is at <https://freeandreducedapps.aafes.com/>
