

Also known as Fastnacht or Karneval, it's the one time in Germany when "Ordnung" doesn't rule.





The preparation begins on Jan. 6 (Epiphany), when town and city organizations start planning fests, carvival balls and the building of floats. The true Fasching celebration, like Mardi Gras, is always the week before Ash Wednesday - making Fasching 2020 fall between Feb. 20-25.

The week of celebrations kicks off with Weiberfastnacht on Feb. 20. It's traditional that women 'take back' the town by storming town hall, dress up as witches or wear other costumes and cut off the ties of men they encounter (with permission, of course).



For the next 3 days, each region will celebrate Fasching according to their varying customs with parties, balls, public stage events (music, dancing, comedy) and street carnivals in neighborhoods all across the city. The Narren (fools) take over the pedestrian zone for three days (Sunday-Tuesday) and turn it into a big open-air party. Much of the town dresses up, painting their faces and taking to the streets in celebration. Vast amounts of food





Rosenmontag on Feb. 24, is the day of the big parades up north in Cologne, Dusseldorf, Mainz and Bonn, with beautifully constructed floats designed to poke fun at politicians and public figures. Candy and small prizes are thrown from the floats in huge amounts, and merrymaking and revelry ensues.



Further south, Fasching in Stuttgart follows more in the the tradition of the Swabian Fasnet and it's medieval roots. Sporting wild, hand carved wooden masks of animals, legendary figures and demons, groups of revellers take to the streets to wreak (mild) havoc & drive the bad spirits of winter away.



Late in the night of
Faschingdienstag, Feb. 25,
there are special carnival
bonfires known as the
Nubbelverbrennung, or
'burning of the straw man'.
These bonfires, which
usually take place on the
street in front of pubs, are
a symbolic burning of the
sins committed during
Karneval.

Each carnival celebration has its own typical Narrenruf, or Fool's Shout:

(Bavaria and northern Germany)

Helau!/Hellau!
(Düsseldorf, Mainz, much of Germany)

Hajo!/Hei-Jo! (Berlin, Heidelberg)

Ho Narro! (Konstanz)

Schelle schelle – schellau! (Allgäu)

## CRISPY, CHEESY, MELTY COMFORT! THIS RECIPE ADDS FRESH THYME & APPLE SLICES, BUT THE POSSIBILITIES ARE ENDLESS.

### **Ingredients**

• 4 1/2-inch slices fresh sourdough bread (or crusty bread of your choice)

- 4 tsp fresh thyme
- 1/2 sliced apple of your choice (red for sweeter, green for tart/tangier)
- Approx. 6 thin slices camembert cheese
- Approx. 6 thin slices sharp cheddar
- Fresh ground pepper, to taste



#### **Instructions**

Lay out 4 slices of bread. Add sliced camembert cheese to two slices of sour-dough and sprinkle with thyme and ground pepper. Cut apple into thin slices and arrange them over the camembert. Next, add the slices of cheddar cheese. Put remaining 2 slices of bread on top and press together with your hands. Coat a large non-stick skillet with cooking oil spray, place over medium heat, and put the sandwiches into the skillet cheddar side down. Cook for several minutes, pressing down with spatula occasionally, until cheese begins to melt and the underside of the bread is golden brown. Spray the top sides of the sandwiches, and carefully flip with a spatula. Cook on this side for another few minutes. Once all of the cheese has melted, remove from the pan and place onto a cutting board.

Slice the sandwiches in half and serve immediately!

### **Optional**

Combine gruyere with tomato, or marry turkey and brie with cranberry jam. Pair sage or dill with Havarti. Throw in fresh cress, spicy peppers, thinly sliced mushrooms, or spinach leaves. Try adding blue cheese crumbles and sliced pears to a melty cheese. You're only limited by your imagination!




# FAMILY AND MWR FACILITIES MAP PANZER BARRACKS









