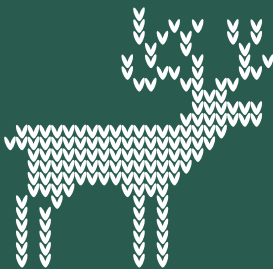

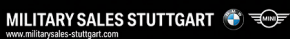

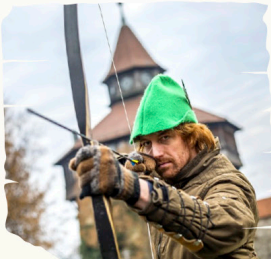


VENDORS & WORKSHOPS

pumpkin SOUP

A SAVORY WINTER SOUP PACKED WITH VITAMINS... PERFECT AS A HOLIDAY MEAL STARTER OR ON IT'S OWN!

Ingredients:

- 1 medium pumpkin, de-seeded and chopped into cubes (2 cups)
- 6 cups vegetable broth (approx.)
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 2 cloves of garlic, crushed
- 1 cup half-and-half
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- Pumpkin seed oil for drizzling



Instructions:

Heat up olive oil in a dutch oven and sauté onions until melted. Add garlic and pumpkin cubes, and sauté until lightly browned. Pour in vegetable broth to cover, and bring it to a boil for 5 minutes. Reduce heat and simmer, uncovered for 30-45 minutes, until pumpkin is soft. Purée the soup in small batches (1 cup at a time) using a food processor, blender, or an immersion blender. Stir in salt, pepper, and half-and-half. Pour into soup bowls and drizzle each serving with pumpkin seed oil.

Enjoy!

- Prep Time: 15 minutes
- Cook Time: 1 hour
- Serves 4 - 6

Kürbiskernöl - pumpkin seed oil is available in the seasoning and/or bio sections of most German supermarkets for around €5,99.



Optional:

Add roasted pumpkin seeds to add crunch and boost the pumpkin flavour, and/or crumble feta cheese on top for an even creamier soup!

CHRISTMAS MARKETS IN & AROUND STUTT GART



Stuttgart Christmas Market

NOVEMBER 27 - DECEMBER 23 • MON - THU 10a.m. - 9p.m.,
FRI & SAT 10a.m. - 10p.m., SUN 11a.m. - 9p.m.

Stuttgart boasts one of Germany's oldest (over 300 years!) and largest Christmas markets. Approximately 290 wooden huts offer everything holiday-related, and the vendors are rewarded for their pains with a prize awarded each year by a jury for the Christmas Market's most beautiful stall. The stalls stretch from the New Palace and the Königsbau, across Schiller Square with the Old Palace and the Collegiate Church, to the Marketplace.



Ludwigsburg Baroque Christmas Market

NOVEMBER 26 - DECEMBER 22 • 11a.m. - 9p.m.

The grand Baroque palace from the early 18th century would be reason enough to visit, but during the Advent season, more than 175 stalls are an added attraction! Try the Swabian specialties such as "Schupfnudeln" (potato noodles) and "Holzofendinnede", a delicacy similar to tarte flambée, baked in a wood-fired oven. Don't miss the gingerbread, which is traditionally served fresh from the oven!



Tübingen Christmas Market

SUN 11a.m. - 7p.m.

For just one long weekend each year, about 450 Christmas stalls are spread out over the medieval city of Tübingen. Since this market is only for one weekend, expect it to be a bit crowded!



Schorndorf Christmas Village

18 miles east of Stuttgart, the Schorndorf Christmas market and old town alleys are ablaze with light. With only 40 huts, this visit is an intimate experience, but you'll find some great souvenirs and gifts, and can sample delicious traditional food.

Hohenzollern Christmas Castle

FRI 2 - 8p.m., SAT 11 - 8p.m., SUN 11 - 7p.m.

This Christmas Market is for those who want a little something special - and opulent! Held within the grounds of the gorgeous Prussian Hohenzollern castle, vendors present hand-made crafts as well as some culinary treats. There is an entry fee - admission is 10 euro for adults, students and children 16 and under are free. Price includes entry, parking and shuttle bus up to the castle. Truly a magical experience!

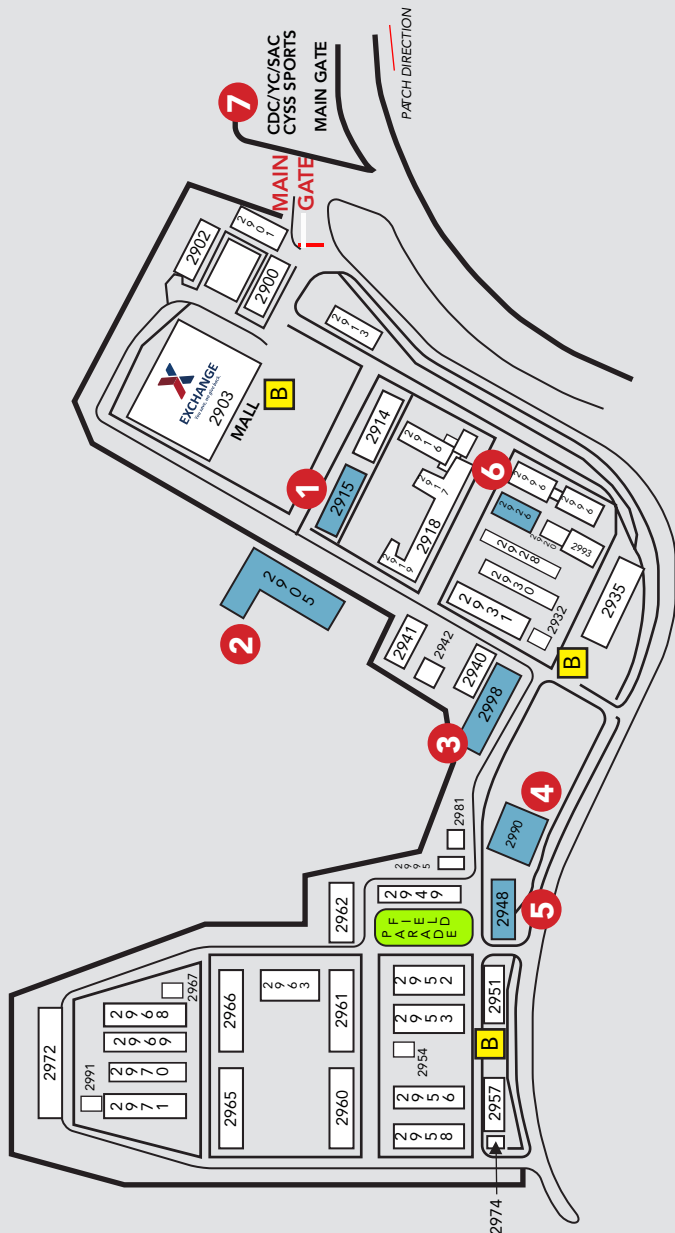

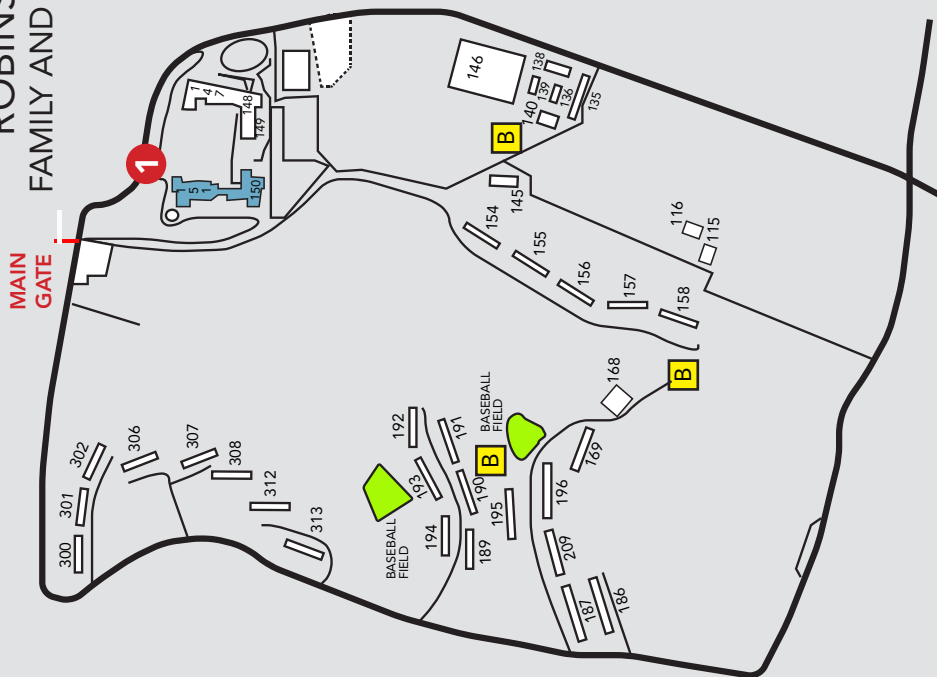

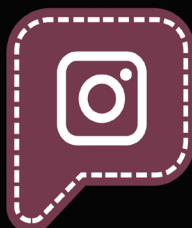
