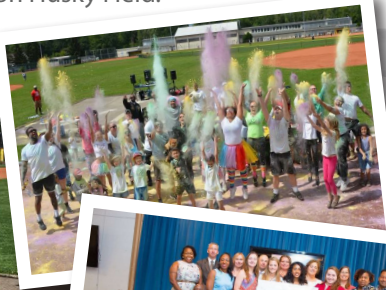

GETTING AROUND

STUTTGART



Stuttgart's public transport system is one of the most modern and efficient in Europe. Whether you're just visiting or plan on using the trains regularly, once you get a handle on how the system works, you'll be hopping on and off the platforms like a seasoned commuter.

BUYING TICKETS

SSB

VIA APP

The easiest way to get your city tickets is to download the VVS or SSB mobile apps (pictured, left). Select your starting and destination point, choose an itinerary, and pay (you can set up an account which stores your credit card info, or link the app to PayPal). The app then generates a bar code that can be scanned by ticket checkers requesting a proof of purchase. Pricing is calculated by zone and/or number of stops, however, using the app is slightly cheaper than buying a ticket at the station.

VIA TICKET MACHINE (OR BUS DRIVER)

Ticket machines for S-Bahn, local and regional trains are available at each station to purchase a paper ticket. Most stations have a touch screen interface, but some older machines require codes to enter in and can be confusing. Not all machines accept credit cards, so always carry Euros! If starting your journey via bus, you can buy a ticket directly from the driver, just tell them your destination (ticket will include S-Bahn, local and regional trains as needed) and they'll print one out for you. Children under 6 travel for free.

VALIDATE

Don't forget to validate your paper ticket! The Deutsche Bahn network and most of the regional networks operate on the honor system. Travelers who purchase paper tickets must stamp their ticket on the train when using the U-Bahn, or at the station platform or entrance to the train station when taking the S-Bahn. Occasionally, staff will circulate throughout the train, checking tickets at random. Not having a valid ticket can result in hefty fines.

TRAVEL OPTIONS

U **Untergrundbahn**, "U-Bahn". The 19-line subway services the immediate city (Zones 1 & 2).

S **Stadtschnellbahn**, "S-Bahn". The 7-line commuter light rail services the city and surrounding areas, such as the airport and cities like Ludwigsburg, Böblingen, Esslingen, and Zuffenhausen (Zones 1-7).

R **Regionalbahn**. These lines branch off from the farthest reaches of the S-Bahn, allowing access to towns like Vaihingen and Dettenhausen. (Zones 5-9)

BUS The bus system services Zones 1-9.

Typically, a ticket purchased for the appropriate zone(s) will be valid for all modes of transport listed above. Public transportation operates daily from about 5am to 1am.

TICKET TYPES (Pricing via app as of January 2019)

SHORT TRIP €1,40

valid from time of purchase for max 3 stops on a bus or U-Bahn and one stop on the S-Bahn.

SINGLE ADULT €2,37 (1 zone)

valid for 3 hours from time of purchase in the direction of the destination for one person.

SINGLE CHILD €1,22 (1 zone)

valid for 3 hours from purchase in direction of destination for one person ages 6-14.

DAY TICKET €5 (1-2 zones)

€8,40 (3-4 zones)
€13 (entire network)
valid from time of purchase until 7am the next day.

SAVOR THIS EASY-TO-MAKE CREAMY SOUP THAT'S PERFECT FOR CHILLY WINTER DAYS.

..... **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1 pound bulk Italian sausage
- 4-6 russet potatoes, cut into bite-sized cubes
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 tablespoons garlic, minced
- 32 ounces chicken broth
- 1/2 bunch kale, (destemmed and cut/torn into bite-sized pieces) OR baby spinach
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream (or half & half)
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Cayenne pepper (optional)
- Shredded Parmesan



..... **INSTRUCTIONS:**

Cook the Italian sausage in a Dutch oven or heavy pot over medium-high heat until crumbly, browned, and no longer pink, 10 to 15 minutes.

Drain, leaving a few tablespoons of drippings in the bottom of the Dutch oven, and set aside. Stir in the onions and garlic in the drippings; cook until onions are soft and translucent, about 5 minutes.

Pour the chicken broth into the Dutch oven with the garlic and onion mixture; bring to a boil over high heat. Add the potatoes, and boil until fork tender, about 20 minutes. Reduce the heat to medium and stir in the heavy cream, kale, and the cooked sausage; cook for 5 minutes or until kale is tender. Add salt, pepper and cayenne to taste. If using baby spinach, add it into the soup just before serving.

Season with salt and pepper and garnish with Parmesan cheese.

Okay, so what CAN'T this thing make?

..... (Spoiler: It can't grill. Yet.)

Just add "Instant Pot" while Googling any recipe and you're guaranteed any number of options to appear for a single dish.

So why the enthusiasm to translate already perfectly good recipes for the Instant Pot? The short answer is probably the greatest selling point of the Instant Pot, namely, its ability to eliminate any 'stand by' aspect of meal preparation. You don't have to babysit a saucepan from boiling over, monotonously keep stirring multiple pots, or check an oven. Just put on the lid, program, and walk away. You also have the great time-saving features that the IP excels in, such as shortening the cook time of unsoaked legumes and rice, cooking fresh & frozen meat to flavorful, fork-tender status, and halving hours-long simmer times for stews.

Like to batch on a Sunday night? It makes multiple meals a breeze, and is ideal for omnivore, paleo and plant-based diets alike. Restrictive diet? A pressure cooker is built to seal in flavor, which means less need for oil, butter and salt. Plus, clean-up is a snap; in most cases, it's just the one inner pot (unless you really decide to commit to IP life, then you have a myriad of pot-in-pot products available to you). You can also program it to start cooking a specific time, or, if you prefer, use the slow-cooker function.

Modern safety features mean that pressure cooking is the safest as it's ever been. Despite assurances from seasoned IP'ers, beginners typically do the "Water Test" (to ensure their IP is fully functional) with the kitchen evacuated and a sentry posted to peek their head round the door at select intervals, tensed for a lid to come flying through the living room wall. Don't worry. Really. There's about a 99% chance it won't, because when the cooker is pressurized, the lid will automatically lock to prevent opening (obviously, don't attempt to force the lid open while the cooker is pressurized).

Full disclosure: It may take a few tries to get the 'knack' of working a new gadget like the IP, but once you do, there are about a million people online that can tell you it's life-changing. The ability to make a quick, nutritious home-cooked meal is the IP's raison d'être.

We've converted the recipe for Zuppa Toscana on page 10 for the Instant Pot, and we've also included instructions for perfect, easy-to-peel hard boiled eggs. Please remember to read your Instant Pot manual carefully and follow all the recommended manufacturer safety guidelines. Happy IP'ing!

Recipes for IP Newbies

ZUPPA TOSCANA

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 pound bulk Italian sausage
- 4-6 russet potatoes, cut into bite-sized cubes
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 tablespoons garlic, minced
- 32 ounces chicken broth
- 1/2 bunch kale, (destemmed and cut/torn into bite-sized pieces) OR baby spinach
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream (or half & half)
- Salt and pepper to taste



INSTRUCTIONS:

Set a 6-qt Instant Pot to the high saute setting. Add olive oil and sausage. Cook, stirring frequently, until sausage is lightly browned, about 3-5 minutes, making sure to crumble the sausage as it cooks.

Drain, leaving a few tablespoons of drippings at the bottom of the Instant Pot. Add garlic and onion. Cook, stirring frequently, until onions have become translucent, about 2-3 minutes. Stir in potatoes and chicken broth; season with salt and pepper.

Select manual setting; adjust pressure to high, and set time for 5 minutes. When finished cooking, quick-release pressure according to manufacturer's directions.

Stir in kale until wilted, about 1-2 minutes. Stir in half and half until heated through, about 1 minute. Season with salt and pepper and garnish with parmesan cheese.

PERFECT HARD-BOILED EGGS

INGREDIENTS:

- 2, 4, 6 or 12 eggs (it's your call!) & 1 cup water

INSTRUCTIONS:

Place 1 cup water in inner pot of Instant Pot. Add in egg or steam rack and gently set eggs as desired on or in rack. Place lid on pressure cooker and set on manual for 5 minutes on high pressure. Once cook time has elapsed, let pressure release naturally for 5 minutes. Then quick release and (carefully) remove eggs and place in ice water bath.

Let eggs sit in water bath for 5 minutes, then remove. Crack egg on counter top and remove shell. Store in fridge for up to 7 days.

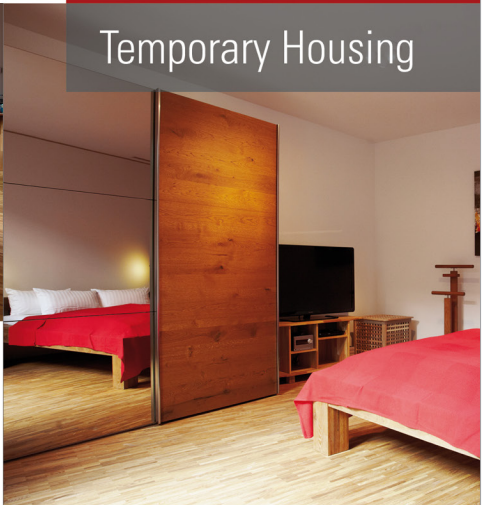

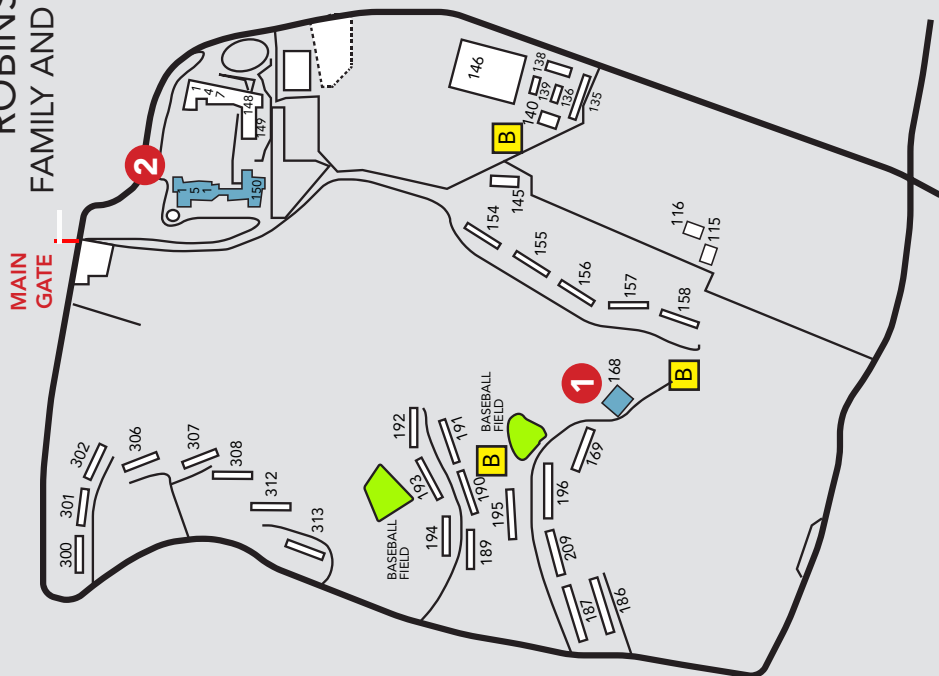

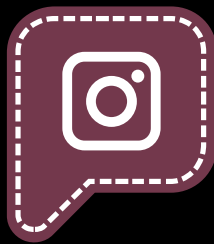
