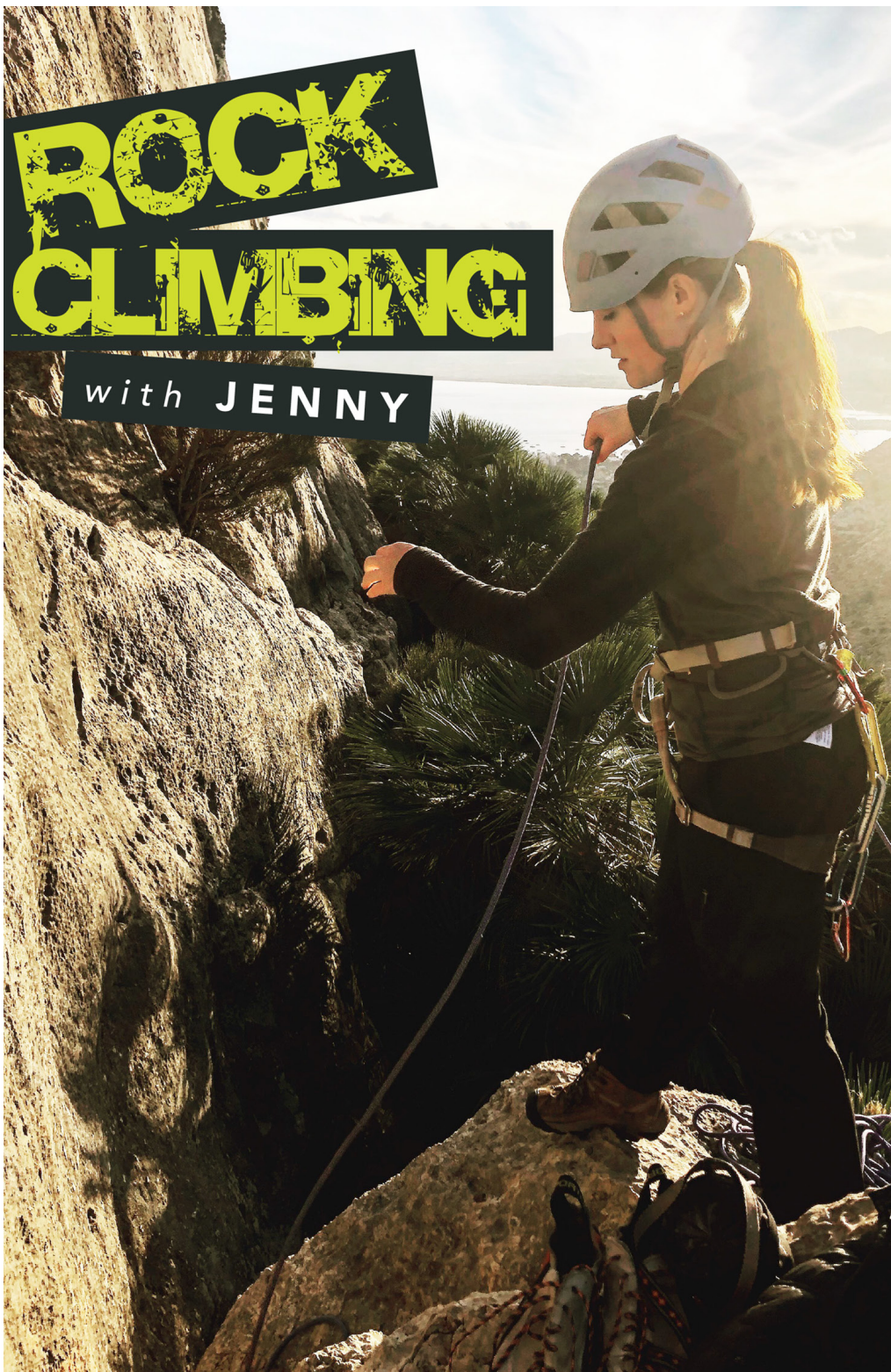

ROCK CLIMBING

with JENNY



Meet Jenny Tomaszewski, Stuttgart ODR's new Rock Climbing Instructor.

Jenny is ACCT (Association for Challenge Course Technology) Certified and has taught a variety of rock climbing classes for all ages at Ft. Carson, Colorado and Ft. Campbell, Kentucky. She and her husband Patrick met on a climbing trip, and have been together ever since. He even proposed to her at their favorite spot at Pilot's Mountain in North Carolina, where they later married. Among their many other accomplishments, they've scaled the Zugspitze, ice-climbed in Italy, and plan to conquer Mont Blanc.




Tell us about your new program!

I'm so excited to be able to build a climbing program here in beautiful Germany! Starting in June, participants will receive training to be certified in the Panzer Fitness Center, and receive a certification badge determining their climb level. We're only doing indoor climbs for now, but we plan to schedule some excursions. Classes will be split up into beginner and advanced groups, so participants can get the instruction they need and given a climbing area suited to their ability. You can also schedule special event programs, you just need an idea of what you want to get out of the event - is it educational, do you want to teambuild, is it for fun, or exercise? We'll tailor the class to suit your group's needs.

Why did you start climbing?

I'm on the fearless side, so climbing feeds my need for adventure and adrenaline, but in a controlled manner, and using risk management. I was also fortunate enough to develop my existing skillsets with MWR Outdoor Recreation, as well as perfect my instructional skills. I don't see mountains as a standard of achievement for everyone across the board - getting to the top of a 30ft wall might be just as exciting for some as it was for me to reach the top of the Zugspitze at nearly 10,000ft. If you have a fear of heights, climbing can be very rewarding!






What can you learn from climbing?

Responsibility and trust. Climbing can be dangerous! Patrick and I barely knew each other the first day we went climbing, but instantly bonded over trust. That's the foundation for any relationship, you have to be able to trust your partner! It takes personal courage to put yourself into a situation where you're dangling several feet above the earth by what feels like a string, but I know I wouldn't climb as high as I do if I didn't have the support below me.

Tell us a little about your background.

I graduated in 2014 with a degree in Recreation Administration and a minor in Outdoor Leadership from Western Kentucky University. I went to Fort Carson for my student internship the last semester of college, and I worked for MWR Adventure Programs and Education for the 2014 winter season. While there, I learned to rock climb, ice climb, snowboard, and more! I was also given the opportunity to work with the Warrior Adventure Quest (WAQ) program, which offered Active Duty Soldiers the opportunity to participate in high adventure activities like skiing, snowboarding, rock climbing, paintball, mountain biking, and white water rafting.



What's been your favorite trip so far?

We've been in Germany since June 2018 and have already taken full advantage of the Alps and beautiful scenery! Our favorite trip so far was climbing the Zugspitze. We did it over two days, with the first day spent hiking to the Höllentalangerhütte to stay the night in the hut, then taking off the next morning to hike, scramble, and climb the rest of the way out by the Via Ferrata (Italian for "iron path"). Interestingly, Via Ferrata is a universal term used to mean the climbing routes through the Alps, but the German speaking countries use their own word, Klettersteig.

I am passionate about introducing others to the world of climbing, and being their guide! I hope to help kids conquer their fears - you CAN reach the top with a little courage and trust. I want to inspire groups to work better together with team-building exercises, and I want to give the Soldiers and family members a new hobby that promotes resiliency, fitness and the spirit of adventure.

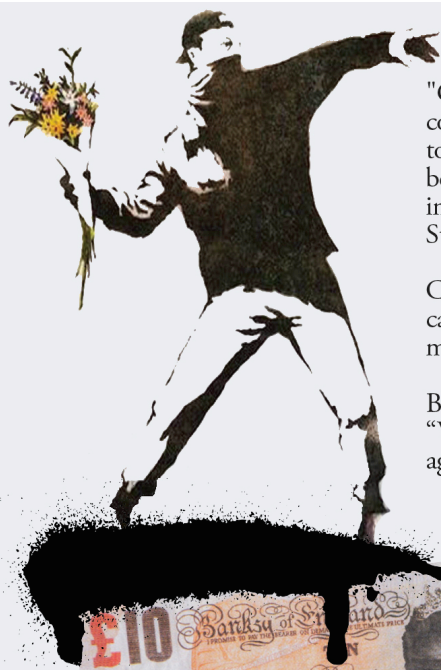

*Streetart anarchist Banksy's "Love is in the Bin"
will be travelling around Stuttgart's Staatsgalerie
on a permanent loan.*



"Girl With Balloon", Banksy's artwork which commanded €1.2M at a Sotheby's auction prior to being partially destroyed by a hidden shredder before horrified bidders (now renamed, "Love is in the Bin"), will be permanently on loan at the Staatsgalerie Stuttgart from March 7, 2019.

Christiane Lange, director of the Staatsgalerie, called it a "noble gesture of the collector" to make the artwork available on a permanent basis.

But be warned: It won't stay in the same place. "Visitors have to go through the Staatsgalerie again and again until they find Banksy."

Yet shredding his picture has only increased it's visibility and therefore, value. Now, prospective viewers will have to hunt through a gallery of old and modern masters to discover a half-destroyed stencil that's now worthless except as an abstraction. Whatever Banksy's true intent was, it's both a joke and a master stroke for the weird validity of conceptual art.

It also sounds like fun - a good excuse to wander the impressively curated Staatsgalerie, while playing a game of Spot-the-Banksy.

PCS season is upon us, and, as most of us know, changing one's duty station is never a totally smooth experience. That's why being a good sponsor is so important to ensure that incoming service members, families & civilians arrive in Stuttgart with as little stress and complication as possible.

How can I be an awesome sponsor, you ask? Well, Stuttgart Army Lodging is here to help you assist your guests into their new community! The Stuttgart Lodging Program is comprised of 2 hotels, the Panzer Hotel and the Kelley Hotel. Both are in high demand, especially during the late spring and early summer (PCS Season).

STEP 1: MAKE RESERVATIONS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

Don't wait for orders, you can always alter the reservation later.

STEP 2: HOW MANY GUESTS, AND ARE THERE PETS?

Please ensure that you reserve the room based on how many adults, children & pets are in the party, as this will dictate what type of room (pet room) and amenities (cribs, rollaways) they will receive. The reservation should be for at least 60 nights for active duty and 90 for civilians. Please contact us immediately if there are any changes to your guests' arrival date, as they will not only be charged as a no-show if lodging is not informed, but their reservation will be cancelled as well - so tell us ASAP!

STEP 3: WHAT TIME ARE THEY ARRIVING? We know first-hand that everyone arrives exhausted from their travels, and we want their check-in experience to be as painless as possible. With this in mind, please know that due to our high demand and turnover requirements, we have a strict check-in time of 3 p.m. This means that in almost all cases, early check-in will not be possible, so if the guest(s) are arriving earlier, the room will have to be booked for the night before. The guest must authorize this in advance, and the finance office will not reimburse the additional cost. If we do have a clean room available (that meets the length of stay) for early check-in, we will of course accommodate, but due to our high occupancy, this is not likely nor can we guarantee it - so plan accordingly.

Sponsors need to provide specific information to make a reservation, but don't worry, we've made a list on the next page, that also includes our current room rates and types. Remember, if you have any questions at all about making a reservation, altering an existing reservation, or about any stage in the sponsorship process, please don't hesitate to contact us at any time - that's what we're here for!

easy INSTANT POT CHICKEN PHO



PHO BROTH

- 2 teaspoons avocado or olive oil
- 3-inch piece of ginger, peeled & halved lengthwise
- 1 large yellow onion, peeled and halved
- 4 cups low-sodium chicken broth
- 2 tablespoons fish sauce
- 4 bone-in chicken thighs (5 ounces each), skin removed, fat trimmed. chopped
- Small bunch fresh cilantro
- 1/2 tablespoons coriander seeds
- 1/2 tablespoon raw sugar



BOWLS

- 4 shallow bowls
- 5 ounces rice stick noodles
- 1 cup bean sprouts
- 2 large scallions, sliced
- 1/2 cup basil leaves
- 1 fresh jalapeño pepper, thinly sliced
- 1 lime, cut into wedges
- Sriracha sauce (optional)



LET'S COOK

◦ *For the Pho broth*, press the sauté button on the pressure cooker. When hot, add the oil and ginger, and place the onion halves in the bottom of the pressure cooker, cut side down. Cook, without moving, until they are both charred, 4-5 minutes. Stir in 1 cup water, the broth, fish sauce, cilantro, coriander seeds, and sugar. Add the chicken thighs.

Seal and cook on high pressure for 18 mins, until the chicken is tender. Quick release, and open when pressure subsides. Transfer the chicken to a plate. Strain the broth and discard the solids.

◦ *For the bowls*, Return the broth to the pot, press the sauté button and bring the broth to a boil. Add the noodles and cook until pliable and opaque, about 3-4 minutes.

Remove the chicken from the bone, slice, and transfer the 4 shallow bowls. Divide the noodles among the bowls (about 3 1/2 ounces each). Top each bowl with a handful of bean sprouts and equal amounts of the scallions and cilantro.

Pour 1 cup of broth over each bowl and serve topped with the jalapeño, basil, and lime wedges. Add Sriracha for an spicy kick., or additional garnishes like sliced radishes, mushrooms, watercress, and mint.
