

1. Who can attend this event?

3. Where is this event located?

The event will be on Panzer Kaserne again this year, but the event location has moved to behind Building 2915 to accommodate all of the additional activities outside of the tent for guests to enjoy!

4. What does it cost to get in?

General admission is a wristband you will wear, and they're \$15 per person (ages 5+ and kids 4 and under are free). The \$15 wristband grants you access to the event and unlimited activities, as well as to over 90 open seating tables inside the tent!

Please note that all kid activities end at 7 p.m. outside the tent, and the event tent is 18+ after 7 p.m. All sales end one hour prior to closing. Buy your wristbands and drink tokens starting Sept. 1 at Patch Arts & Crafts Center, Galaxy Bowling & Entertainment Center, or Kelley/Robinson Barracks Fitness Centers.

5. Do I need a wristband?

Yes, all attendees ages 5 and up will need a wristband (\$15). Kids 4 and under are free! Wristbands go on sale starting September 1 at Patch Arts & Crafts,

Galaxy Bowling & Entertainment Center, Kelley Fitness Center and Robinson Barracks Fitness Center. Please be aware that the kid activities will be closing at 7 p.m. each night. The wristband will be good for the day, and includes access to all activities and open seating inside of the tent on a space-available basis. Additional seating is also available outside of the tent, also on a first-come, first-served basis. 7. Are children allowed inside the tent after the kid activities close at 7 p.m.?
